- Lead and manage the Malta Senior Men's National Water Polo Team.
- Oversee the technical development of the Junior National Teams and the national athlete development pathway.
- Plan and supervise national team activities, including training camps, international competitions, and major championships.
- Prepare and develop teams for participation in European Aquatics, World Aquatics, and any other competitions approved by the ASA Executive.
- Develop and implement a unified playing philosophy and athlete development pathway.
- Design and oversee high-performance programmes, talent identification initiatives, and school water polo development programmes.
- Collaborate with clubs, coaches, athletes, schools, and other stakeholders to strengthen player development structures.
- Develop and implement a long-term strategic plan aimed at enhancing Malta's international competitiveness.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should possess :

- Recognised Water Polo Coaching Qualifications.
- Proven experience at senior international, professional club, or elite-performance level.
- Strong leadership, communication, and organisational skills.
- Experience in athlete development and high-performance programmes.
- Excellent command of English.

Preference will be given to candidates with previous experience as a National Team Head Coach, Technical Director and/or or High-Performance Director.
