Selection policy

- 1. The objective for this event** is to provide a meaningful and beneficial competitive opportunity to further the long-term development of Maltese swimmers (males born 2003 – 2006 and females born 2004 – 2007) towards senior international success at GSSE (2023 & 2025) and Olympic (2024/2028) levels.
- 2. Selection Period** Selections will be made from individual event performances at ASA approved competitions during the period 1st July 2020 to 9th May 2021. Athletes will be notified of their selections in the week following the end of the selection period.
- 3. Team size** Up to a maximum of 8 athletes regardless of gender will be selected for the EJC 2021. There is no obligation on the ASA to select 8 athletes and the total Team Size will be subject to available funding.

- 5. To be eligible for selection**, swimmers must achieve a time in the Heat or Final of the respective event at the ASA approved competitions during the qualifying period equal to or better than an individual event Time Standard. A Maximum of **four** swimmers can be selected in one event.

 - be a Maltese citizen
 - be a registered ASA member of the 2019-2020/2020-2021 seasons
 - be available to fulfil National Team commitments
